Tinker Field Research Grants fund the travel and partial logistical costs of graduate students that will be doing preliminary research in Latin America. The objective of this grant is to provide students with the opportunity to immerse themselves into their perspective fields and attain language knowledge, cultural background, initiate research contacts, network with institutions and possible informants and/or research projects, and gather preliminary research data.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIAS:

- Applicants must attend an information session in order to apply
- Must be enrolled in a Master's degree program, Ph.D., or a professional degree program
- Grant can only be used for preliminary research in 2025
